<b>Abelia x grandiflora</b> Attractive semi-evergreen shrub with arching branches. Bearing glossy oval leaves and clusters of long-lasting, pale-pink flowers from mid-summer. Ht.2m x 2m	£12.95	2L
<b>Abelia x grandiflora 'Radiance' (V)</b> Attractive semi-evergreen shrub with arching branches. Bearing white variegated leaves and clusters of long-lasting, pale-pink, flowers from mid-summer. Slightly tinged pink foliage tips in winter. Ht.1m x 1.5m	£12.95	2L
<b>Abutilon megapotamicum 'Wisley Red'</b> Semi-evergreen shrub with slender arching stems and climbing habit. Lance to heart-shaped green leaves. Bell-shaped flowers with orange-red petals from summer into autumn. Ht. 1.5m x 1m	£15.00	2L
<b>Acer japonicum 'Vitifolium' AGM</b> Small deciduous tree or large bushy shrub. Broad, fan-shaped leaves with stunning purple, crimson and orange autumn colours. Ht.2.5m x 2.5m	£25.00	3L

<p><b>Acer palmatum</b> Large shrub or small deciduous tree of varied habit. Fresh green palmate leaves with red, orange or yellow autumn colours. Ht.2.5-4m x 2.5m</p>	£15.00	2L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Atropurpureum' (A)</b> Striking purple leaf Japanese maple which makes a small tree or bushy shrub. Palmate leaves turning red in autumn. Ht.4m x 4m</p>	£15.00	2L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Akane' (P)</b> Attractive Japanese maple with compact upright habit. Bright apricot palmate leaves in spring, turning yellow-green then orange in autumn. Best in partial shade. Ht.2.5m x 1.5m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Beni-maiko'(P) AGM</b> Small bushy maple with compact rounded habit. Brilliant red young foliage in spring, becoming greenish red in summer and fiery red in autumn. Name means 'red-haired dancing girl'. Ht. 3m x 3m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Bloodgood'</b> One of the best purple leaved maples. Deciduous with upright, broad-topped habit. Rich red/purple palmate leaves with bright crimson and blood red autumn colours. Ht. 5m x 4m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Chitose-yama' (M) AGM</b> Graceful Japanese maple, deciduous with compact mound habit. Palmate leaves emerge light red, turning bronze green then scarlet in autumn. Ht. 1.5m x 1.5m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Deshōjō' (P)</b> Striking bright red spring colour. Palmate leaves turn bright green for summer then scarlet in autumn. Upright, rounded habit. Small reddish flowers in spring, red winged fruit in autumn. Ht. 2.5m x 2.5m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Dissectum Nigrum' (D)</b> Graceful, spreading and weeping Japanese maple that forms a mound habit. Feathery burgundy-red leaves, with bronze shades, turning red in autumn. Small red flowers in spring followed by red winged fruits in autumn. Ht. 1.5m x 2m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum Dissectum Viride Group</b> Beautiful low growing and weeping Japanese maple that forms a mound habit. Feathery leaves that are lime-green in summer, turning shades of red, orange and gold in autumn. Red flowers in spring followed by winged fruit in autumn. Ht. 2m x 1.5m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Elegans'</b> Deeply divided, green leaved acer known for its spectacular autumn colour of yellow to bright orange and tinted red. Elegant, compact and nicely branched. Easy variety to grow. Ht. 2.5m x 2m</p>	£25.00	3L

<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Emperor 1' (A)</b>  Attractive Japanese maple with strong upright habit. Deep red-purple, large palmate leaves turning crimson in autumn. Foliage appears later than other cultivars reducing risk of frost damage. Ht. 5m x 4m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Katsura' (P) AGM</b>  Stunning upright Japanese maple. Palmate leaves emerge golden orange with pink tips in spring, becoming green in summer then bright orange in autumn. Ht. 4m x 2.5m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Kinshi' (L) AGM</b>  Graceful Japanese maple with compact, upright but slightly weeping habit. Deeply cut linear leaves give a feathery appearance, emerging vivid green and turning yellow to striking orange in autumn. Ht. 1.5m x 1.5m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Koto-no-ito' (L)</b>  Pretty Japanese maple with slow growing upright habit and rounded canopy. Bright green, narrow linear leaves, turning golden orange in autumn. Its name translates to 'harp strings'. Ht. 2m x 2m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Linearilobum' (L)</b>  Graceful Japanese maple, with compact upright habit and rounded crown. Deeply divided palmate leaves with narrow lobes. Fresh green in spring becoming tinged with orange in summer and turning bright yellow in autumn. Ht.4m x4m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Orange-Dream' (P) AGM</b>  Upright bushy Japanese maple. Dark orange spring foliage becoming lemon-yellow with orange-tinged margins &amp; tips. Changing slowly to light green in summer and striking yellow in autumn. Ht. 3m x 2m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Orangeola' (D) AGM</b>  Spectacular Japanese maple with arching branches and mound forming habit. Lacey foliage emerging orange-red in spring, turning reddish-green in summer then bright orange-red in autumn. Ht. 2.5m x 1.5m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Osakazuki' (A) AGM</b>  One of the best Japanese maples for autumn colour. Upright habit with rounded crown. Bright green palmate leaves turning fiery scarlet in autumn. Small red flowers in spring and winged fruit in autumn. Ht. 4m x 3m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Red Pygmy' (L)</b>  Japanese maple with slow growing, mound shaped habit. Delicate looking strap-like leaves emerging red-purple and turning red/scarlet in autumn. Small purple flowers in spring, red winged fruit in autumn. Ht. 1.5m x 1m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Sango-kaku' (P) AGM</b>  Striking Japanese maple with upright habit and stunning stems in winter. Coral-red young branches bearing palmate leaves which open pinkish-yellow, maturing to bright green in summer then golden yellow in autumn. Ht. 4mx2m</p>	£25.00	3L

<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Starfish' (PBR)</b>  Attractive small Japanese maple, slow growing with upright habit. Starfish-like red-purple palmate leaves that intensify in colour through autumn, providing a fiery display. Perfect small tree or for the patio. Ht.2m x 1m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Tsuma-gaki' (A)</b>  Attractive Japanese maple with compact, rounded habit. Palmate leaves emerging yellow-green with red-purple tips to the lobes. Leaves turn darker green in summer and shades of red and crimson in autumn. Ht. 2.5m x 2m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Twombly's Red Sentinel'</b>  Attractive Japanese maple with dense, upright, columnar habit, eventually spreading as it ages. Palmate leaves emerging bright red, maturing purple-red or reddish green. Red shades in autumn. Ht.3m x 2m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Villa Taranto' (L) AGM</b>  Beautiful Japanese maple with dome-shaped habit. Attractive strap-like leaves emerge reddish and mature green with reddish overtone, followed by golden autumn colour. Small red flowers in spring and winged fruit in autumn. Ht. 2m x 1.5m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer shirasawanum 'Jordan'</b>  Stunning maple with bushy upright habit and outstanding foliage. Palmate leaves emerge pretty yellow-orange, brightening to lime-green and turning spectacular oranges and reds in autumn. Contrasting small red flowers. Ht.3mx 2m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer shirasawanum MOONRISE</b>  Stunning maple with bushy upright habit and outstanding foliage. Palmate leaves emerge bright red, turning lime green as they mature. Spectacular oranges and reds in autumn. Contrasting red flowers and winged fruits. Ht.2m x 2m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Agapanthus 'Sea Storm'</b>  Beautiful summer colours from June-August. Clump forming evergreen perennial with lush green stap-like leaves. Sturdy, upright stems of star-shaped, violet blue flowers, with darker stripe running through each petal. Ht. 75cm x 60cm</p>	£12.50	2L
<p><b>Agapanthus 'Silver Lining'</b>  A striking new hybrid with unique form. Clump forming deciduous perennial with lush green stap-like leaves. Sturdy, upright stems of semi-pendulous, white blooms with faint lilac stripes from July-September. Ht.75cm x 45cm</p>	£12.50	2L
<p><b>Akebia quinata</b>  Semi-evergreen climber with attractive leaflets, commonly known as chocolate vine. Chocolatey scented, violet-purple flowers, sometimes followed by sweet sausage shaped fruit. Ht.6m x 2m</p>	£17.50	2L

<p><b>Ampelopsis brevipedunculata 'Elegans' (v)</b>  Attractive deciduous climber with densely mottled, white and pink tinged, green leaves. Modest growing, good option for covering smaller areas. Gem-like turquoise fruit after a hot summer. Ht.2.5m x 1.5m</p>	£17.50	2L
<p><b>Anisodonteia capensis</b>  Compact evergreen to semi-evergreen sub-shrub with small hairy leaves. Profusion of hibiscus-like flowers with pink outer and dark pink centres in summer and autumn. Ht. 80cm x 80cm</p>	£15.00	2L
<p><b>Anisodonteia African Rose Rufaro (PBR)</b>  Bushy evergreen shrub or sub-shrub with deeply lobed, fuzzy, deep-green foliage. Hibiscus-like deep pink flowers, with darker veins, that appear profusely throughout the summer. Ht. 80cm x 60cm</p>	£15.00	2L
<p><b>Anisodonteia capensis ELEGANS PRINCESS</b>  Compact evergreen to semi-evergreen sub-shrub with small hairy leaves. Profusion of hibiscus-like flowers, with pink outer and dark pink centres, in summer and autumn. Loved by butterflies and bees. Ht.1m x 0.8m</p>	£15.00	2L
<p><b>Arbutus unedo 'Atlantic'</b>  Small evergreen tree or shrub with glossy dark green leaves. A choice form with profuse, bell shaped, white flowers and abundant orange/red fruit, even on young plants. Ht. 2.5m x 2.5m</p>	£17.50	2L
<p><b>Arbutus unedo 'Compacta'</b>  Compact evergreen shrub with glossy dark green leaves and attractive shredding red-brown bark. White bell-shaped flowers, sometimes pink tinged. Orange/red strawberry-like fruit in autumn. Ht.2.5m x 2m</p>	£17.50	2L
<p><b>Berberis darwinii AGM</b>  Dense evergreen shrub with holly-like, glossy, dark green leaves. Drooping clusters of bright orange flowers that are tinged red in bud, over a long period in early spring. Followed by blue-black autumn berries. Ht. 1.5m x 1.5m</p>	£12.95	2L
<p><b>Berberis thunbergia f. atropurpurea 'Admiration' (PBR) AGM</b>  Dwarf deciduous shrub with rounded compact habit. Attractive rich red foliage with narrow yellow/green margin. Brilliant autumn foliage and bright red berries. Ht.50cm x 50cm</p>	£12.95	2L
<p><b>Berberis thunbergia f. atropurpurea 'Red Pillar'</b>  Deciduous shrub, initially columnar, slightly spreading with age. Reddish-purple leaves that turn brilliant crimson in autumn. Yellow flowers in spring, followed by red berries. Ht.1.2m x 1m</p>	£12.95	2L
<p><b>Berberis thunbergii 'Desperados' (PBR)</b>  Deciduous shrub with broad, rounded habit. Spectacular bright foliage that changes colour. Dark orange new shoots, changing to red in summer, greening in older foliage which provides beautiful contrast. Ht. 60cm x 60cm</p>	£12.95	2L

<p><b>Berberis thunbergii 'Golden Rocket' (PBR)</b>  Colourful deciduous shrub with columnar habit. Bright golden foliage in spring, turns lime green in summer and vibrant shades of orange in autumn. Small yellow flowers in spring followed by red berries. Ht. 1.2m x 0.6m</p>	£12.95	2L

<p><b>Buddleja Little Cerise (PBR) (Butterfly Candy Series)</b>  Compact deciduous shrub, ideal for the smaller space or patio. Lance-shaped green leaves. <p><b>Buddleja 'Poquito Magenta Munchkin'</b> Compact deciduous shrub, ideal for the smaller space or patio. Lance-shaped leaves that are grey green above and white felted beneath. <p><b>Callicarpa dichotoma 'Issai'</b> Bushy deciduous shrub with compact, rounded habit. Slightly serrated green leaves, turning yellow in autumn. <p><b>Ceanothus 'Blue Mound'</b>  Bushy evergreen shrub with dense mound habit and glossy dark green leaves. Masses of deep blue flowers in compact heads late spring. Attractive to butterflies and bees. Ht.1m x 1.5m</p>	£12.95	2L
